Special Event Permit Applications

Hartford Park

The Homemakers presented a letter requesting a clean-up of Hartford Park including a visible circle around the consecrated tree that is not stone. They also presented wording for the new plaque.

Amy said that she will have someone look at the trees in Hartford Park.

Rotary proposal

Martha's Vineyard Rotary proposed putting musical instruments in a park. They would like to see it in a community area rather than at a school.

Amy had concerns about maintenance as well as neighbors of any park area. She explained most the parks are in neighborhoods with many houses and she did not want people playing the instruments late at night.

It was suggested that they look at area near the Sea View bathrooms as it is more in a commercial area with the SSA next to it. Also the OBPD was across the street. They were advised to request permission from the Board of Selectmen if they decide on that location.

Special Event Permit Applications

- REVISED MV Marathon & Half Marathon; Waban/Alley Park – Friday & Saturday, May 17-18, 2019

Brian Yarbor requested the addition of a beer garden for participants and their guests after the race. He advised that they would provide space from local businesses where they would provide the permitting costs. He said that the event would be over by 2:00 PM and that the clean-up would be done around 5:00 PM.

Motion: To preliminary approve MV Marathon & Half Marathon's revised application. By: Member Lima. Second: Member Billings. Motion passed unanimously 2-0.
