Dave advised that the Selectmen have no issue with volunteers being on the Town boat. He said that it was department policy that if one is out on the boat by oneself or when in outside waters that life jacket must be worn and when in the ponds with others, the life jackets must be on the boat.

Chuck said that he will check all life jackets to make sure that they are functioning.

Member Alwardt said that someone had done cutting down to the water's edge in Sengekontacket.

Dave replied that the Conservation Commission is aware of the situation.
