The Town of Oak Bluffs, MA is requesting bids for the following:

County Road Drainage Improvements

THIS PROJECT IS BEING ELECTRONICALLY BID AND HARD COPY BIDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Please review the instructions in the bid documents on how to register as an electronic bidder. The bids are to be prepared and submitted at www.biddocsonline.com. Tutorials and instructions on how to complete the electronic bid documents are available online (click on the "Tutorial" tab at the bottom footer).

The Town of Oak Bluffs, Massachusetts, the Awarding Authority, invites sealed bids from General Contractors for the County Road Drainage Improvements at approximate address of 271 County Road in the TOWN OF Oak Bluffs, Massachusetts, in accordance with the documents prepared by HORSLEY WITTEN GROUP, INC. dated April 2019.

The work to be performed under the Base Bid of this contract includes, but is not limited site clearing, surface and subsurface drainage improvements, earthwork, paving, erosion and sediment control, management and control of traffic, and stabilization of disturbed areas.

Construction shall begin after the Notice of Proceed.

Bidding procedures and award of Contract and subcontracts are subject to the provisions of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts applicable sections of MGL c.30. Estimated cost of the contract is \$253,000.

General Bids will be received until **JULY 10, 2019 at 10:00AM** and publicly opened, forthwith online.

All Bids should be submitted electronically online at www.biddocsonline.com and received no later than the date and time specified above.

General bids shall be accompanied by a bid deposit that is not less than five (5%) of the greatest possible bid amount (considering all alternates), and made payable to the **Town of Oak Bluffs**.

The **Pre-Bid Conference** and site visit will be on **JUNE 27, 2019 at 10:45 AM** local time at the site address near 271 County Road, Oak Bluffs, MA. The Pre-Bid Conference is recommended but not mandatory.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Labor and Materials Payment Bond and a Performance Bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount.

Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women's Business Enterprise (WBE) policies are applicable. The goals for this project are blended goals of MBE 3.4% and WBE 3.8%. Within five days after the Bid Opening, the Bidder shall submit a "Schedule for Participation by Minority Business Enterprises" with accompanying Letters of Intent by each minority subcontractor proposed to be used by the Bidder. The Bidder shall submit a "Schedule for Participation by Women Business Enterprises" with accompanying Letters of Intent by each WBE subcontractor to be used by the Bidder. The Letters of Intent shall include, among other things, the contract items the M/WBE is proposing to perform and the prices that the M/WBE proposed to charge for the work. Original signed copies of the letters will be required prior to the signing of a contract. The Schedule of Participation shall list these M/WBE subcontractors with whom the Contractor intends to contract and state the total price to be paid each M/WBE contractor as taken from each Letter of Intent submitted with the bid. The Bidder shall submit a copy of current SBA letter of Minority Business Enterprise or Women Business Enterprise Certification for each subcontractor. Failure to comply with the requirements of this paragraph may be deemed to render a proposal non-responsive.

Full compliance with Federal, State and Municipal Wage Laws is required of all work. Minimum Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of Department of Labor and Industries under the provision of the Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 26 to 27D, as amended, apply to this project. It is the responsibility of the contractor, before bid opening, to request if necessary, any additional information on Minimum Wage Rates for those trades people who may be employed for the proposed work under this contract.

All bidders shall be required to submit a Certification of Non-Collusion and State Tax Certification Clause as well as provide Certification of Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Training in accordance with Massachusetts General Law 30: Section 39S, as amended by Chapter 306 of the Acts of 2004, effective 7/1/06.

Bidders are not to include in their Bid Proposal sales and compensating use taxes on materials and supplies purchased for this project. All materials used are tax exempt.

Contractors shall be required to comply with all applicable Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30 S.39M, and other applicable Massachusetts General Laws.

A weekly certified payroll submittal shall be required of the successful bidder in accordance with MGL C149, S27B. No payments will be made until all payroll information necessary for HW to determine compliance with prevailing wage law requirements for the time period of the payment request have been submitted.

The Contractor shall not discriminate with regard to the personnel employed on this project on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, gender, sexual preference, handicap or age.
