As a follow-up to my note below and my April Letter to the Editor. Here is a link to the EPA Report re Artificial Turf that was released in July 2019 after my letter was published. They reviewed the best available evidence to date and conclude:

In general, the findings from the report support the premise that while chemicals are present as expected in the tire crumb rubber, human exposure appears to be limited based on what is released into air or simulated biological fluids
