COVID-19 RECOMMENDATIONS

As Dukes County is no longer classified as a high-risk community, the Oak Bluffs Board of Health has voted to rescind their mask advisory issued on May 18, 2022.

People may still choose to wear a mask at any time and those with symptoms, a positive test, or exposure to someone with COVID-19 should wear a mask.

The Island Boards of Health strongly encourage individuals to follow the COVID-19 Community Level classification guidance issued by the CDC.

Community Level – Low

- Stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines
- Get tested if you have symptoms

Community Level – Medium

- Talk to your health care provider about whether you need to wear a mask and take other precautions if you are at high risk for severe illness
 - Stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines
 - Get tested if you have symptoms

Community Level – High

- Wear a mask indoors in public places
- Stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines
- Get tested if you have symptoms
- Additional precautions may be needed for people at high risk for severe illness
